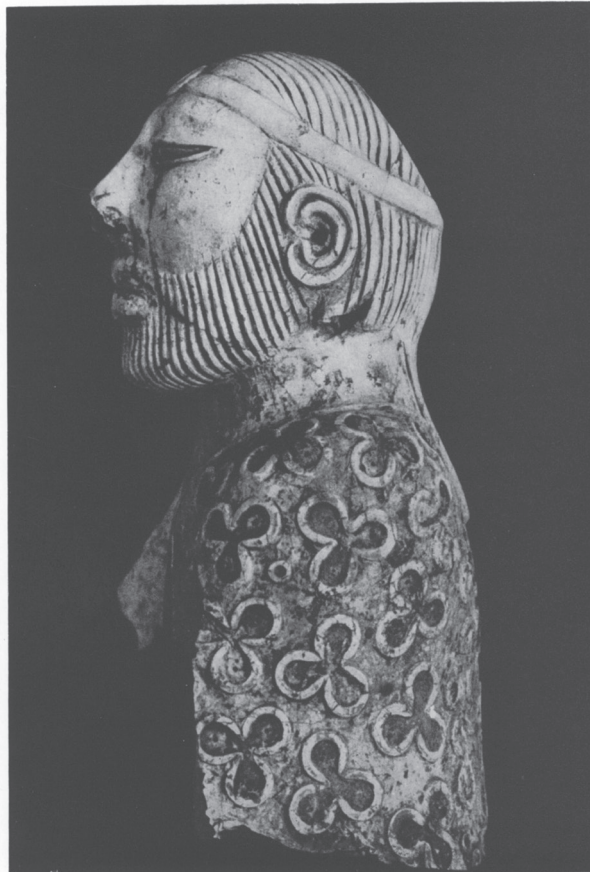

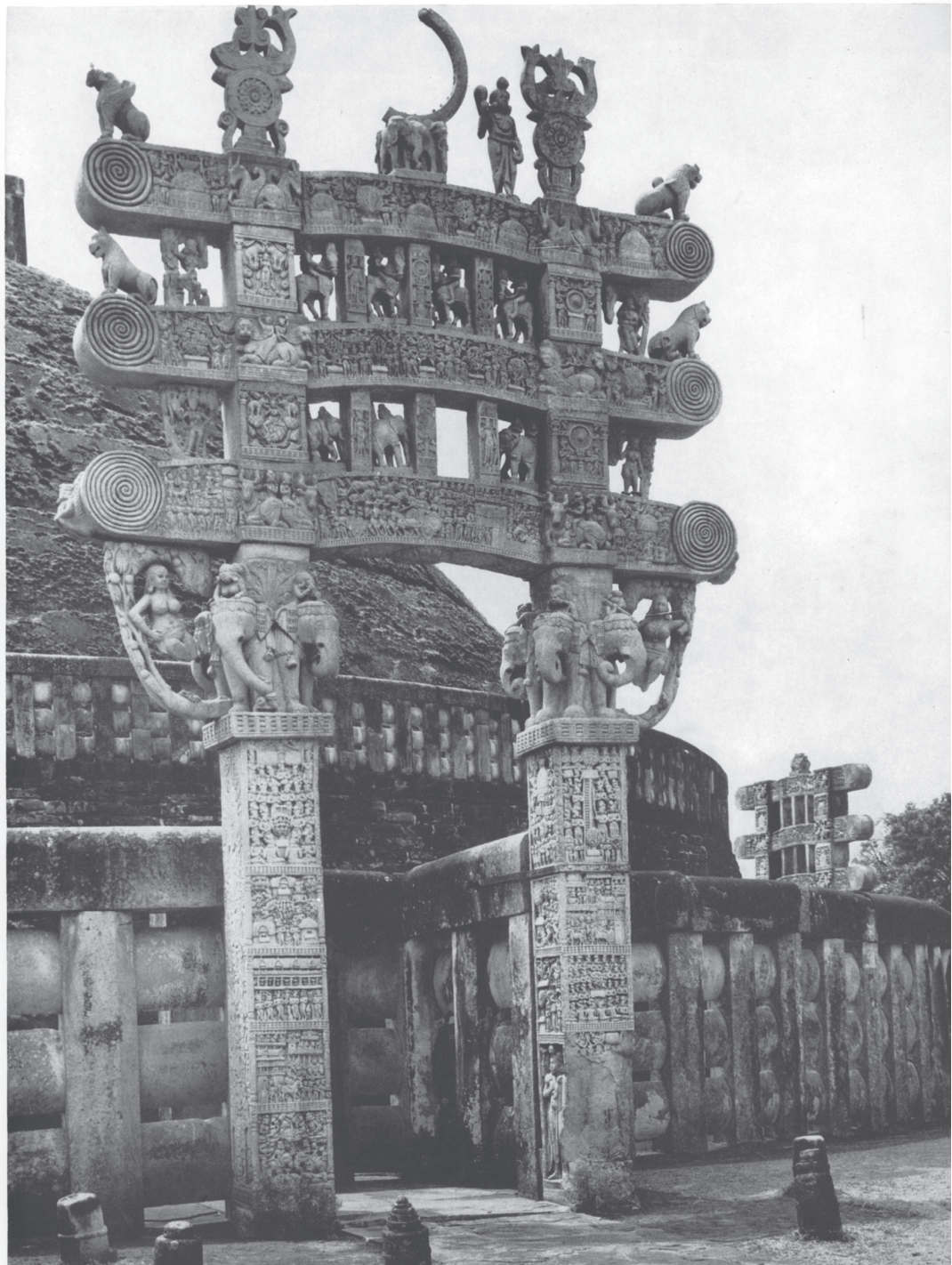

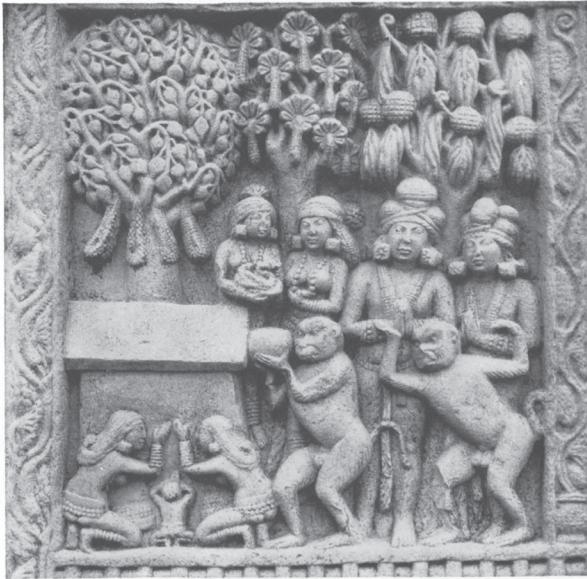

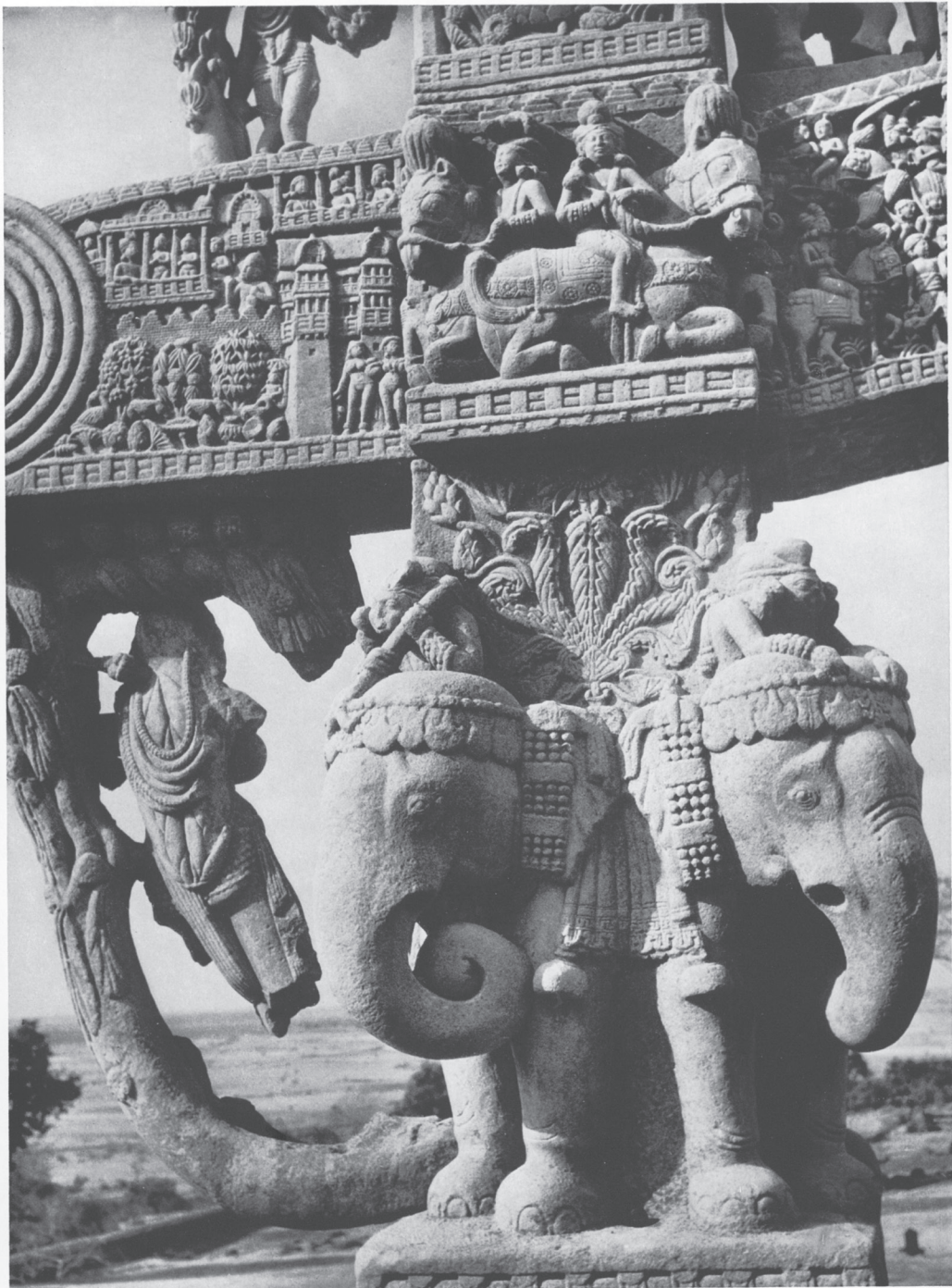

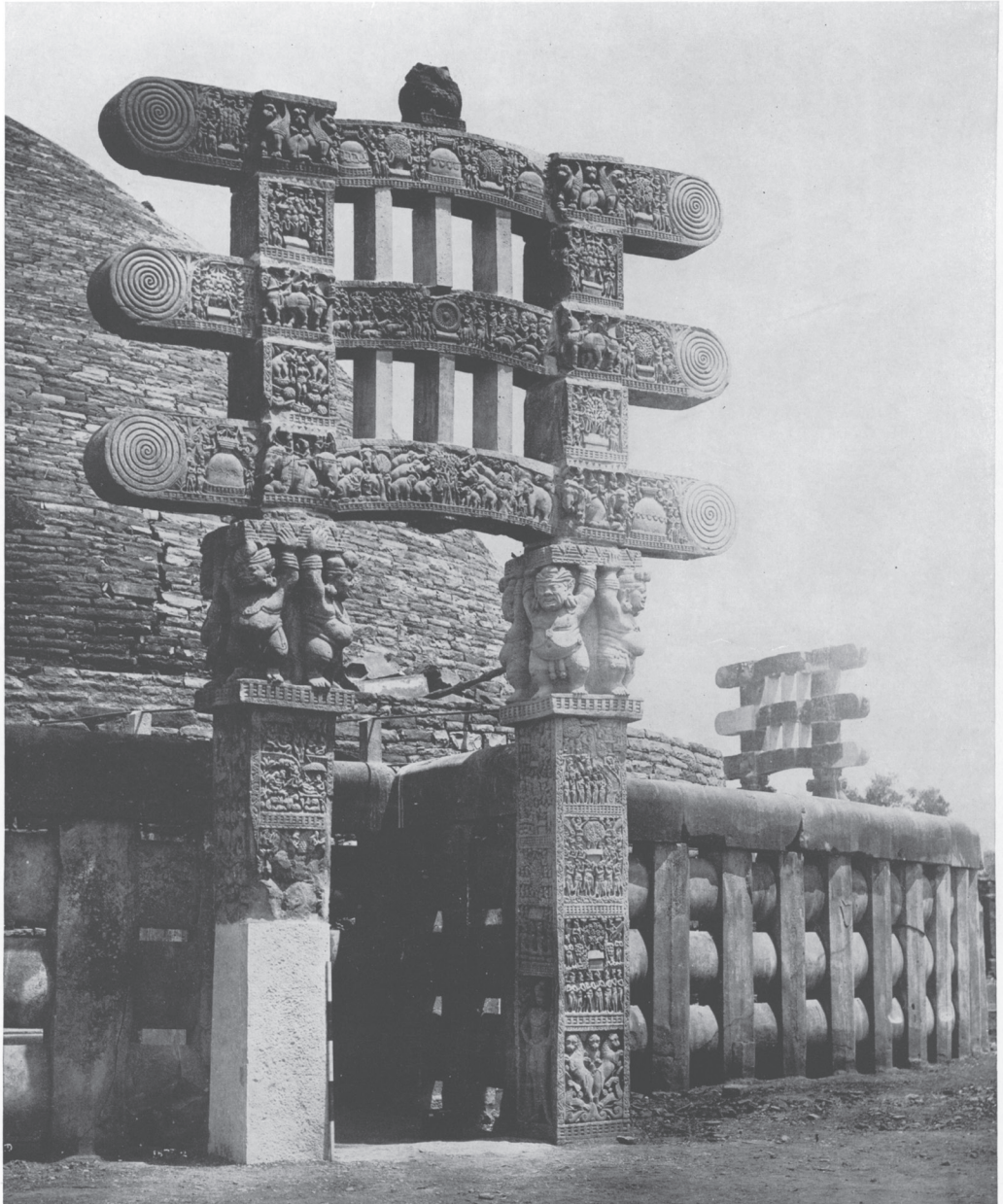

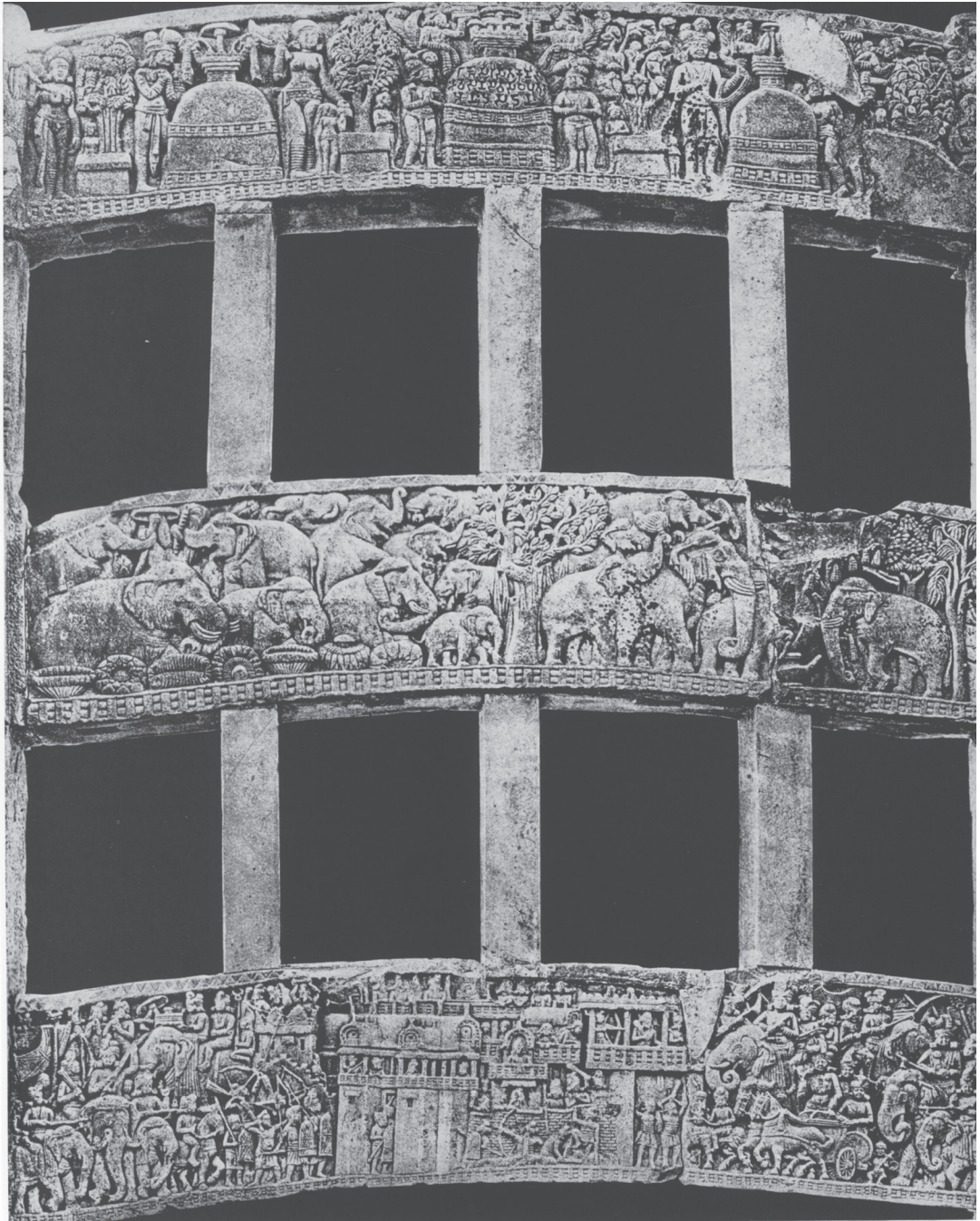

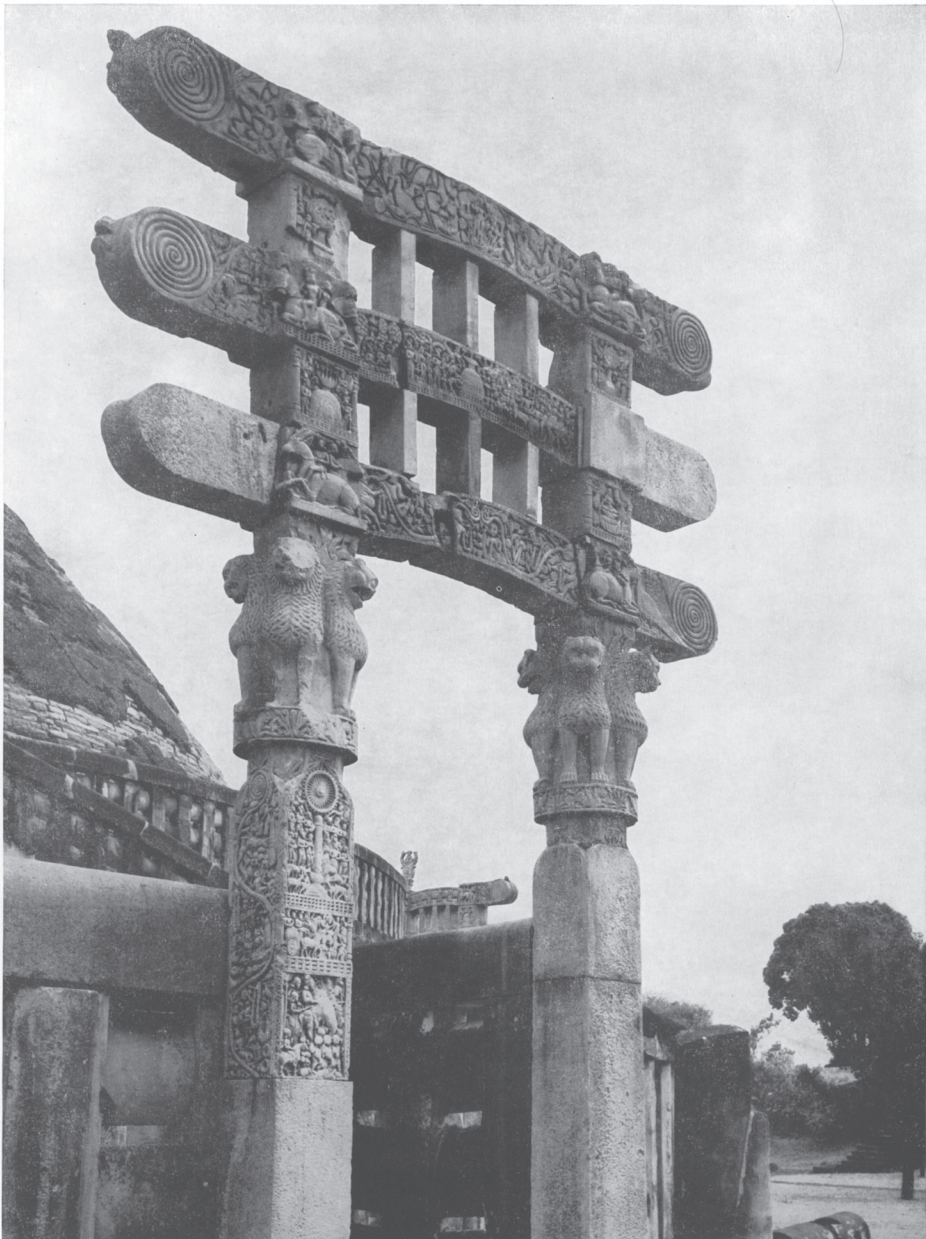


22. Sāñcī. The Great Stūpa. South gate: bracket dryad. Early 1 century A.D.

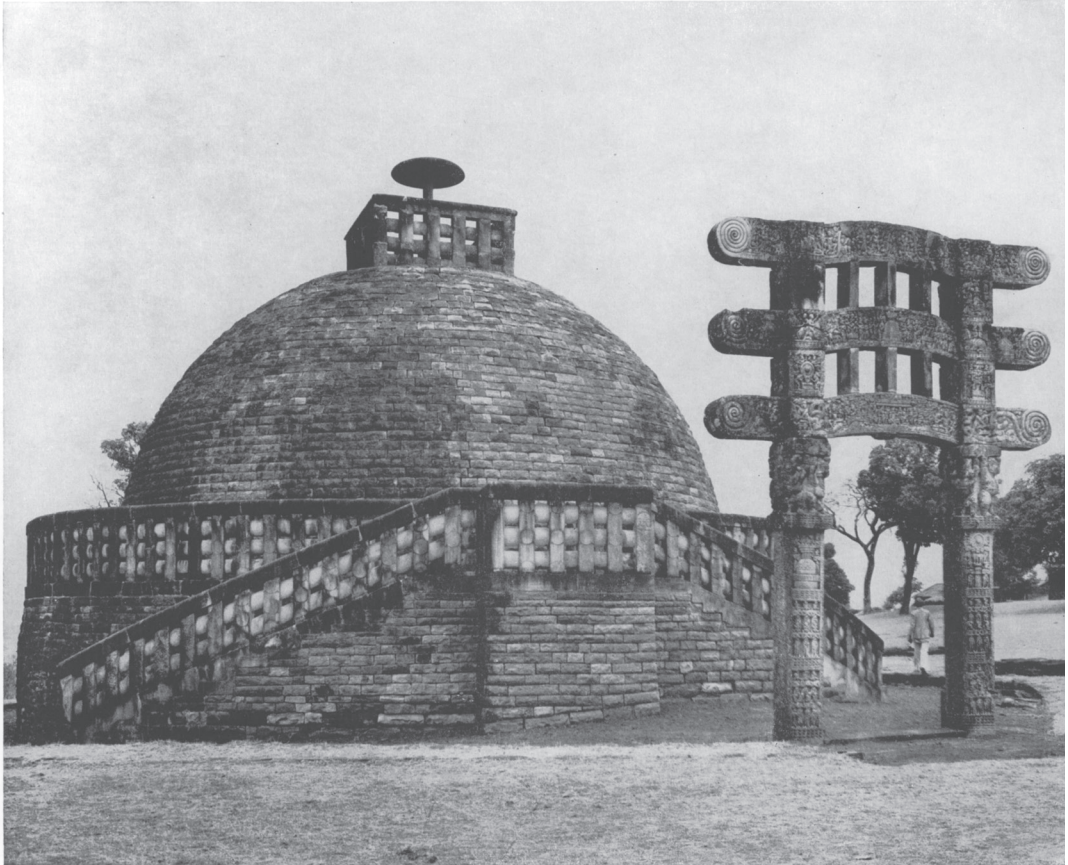




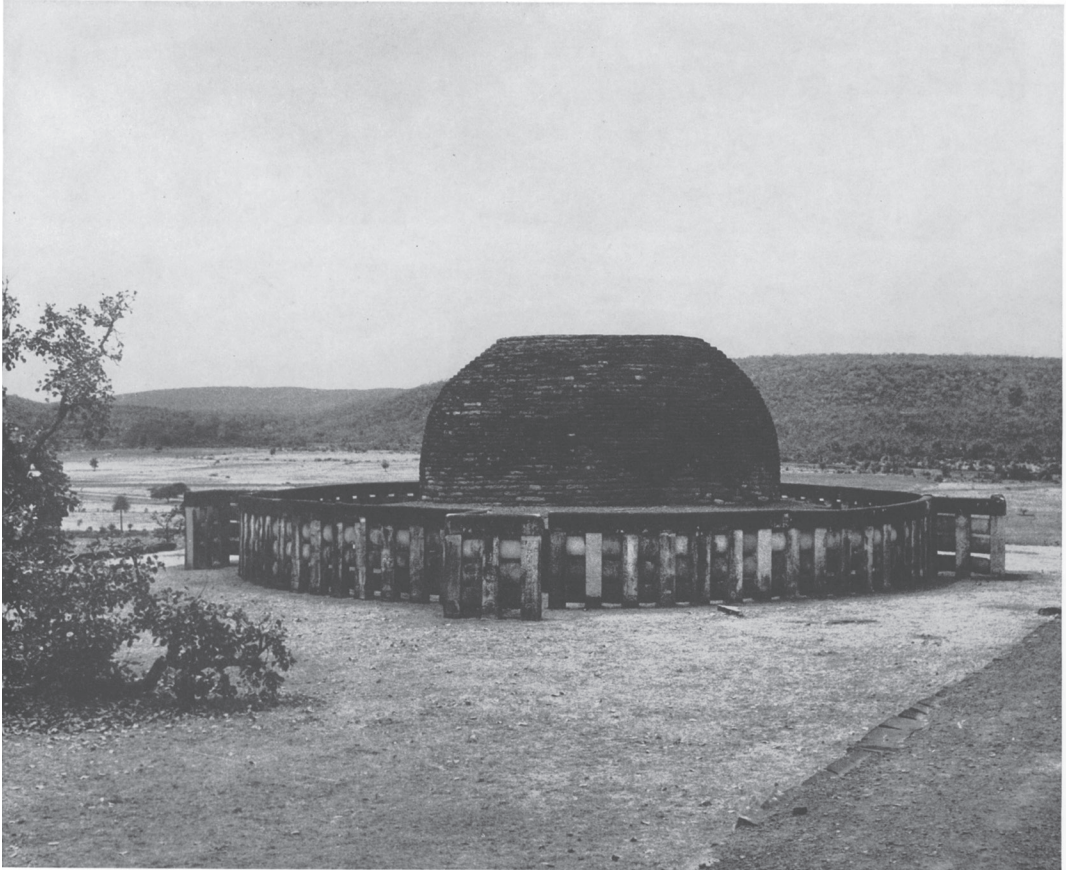
23. South gate, architraves, rear view



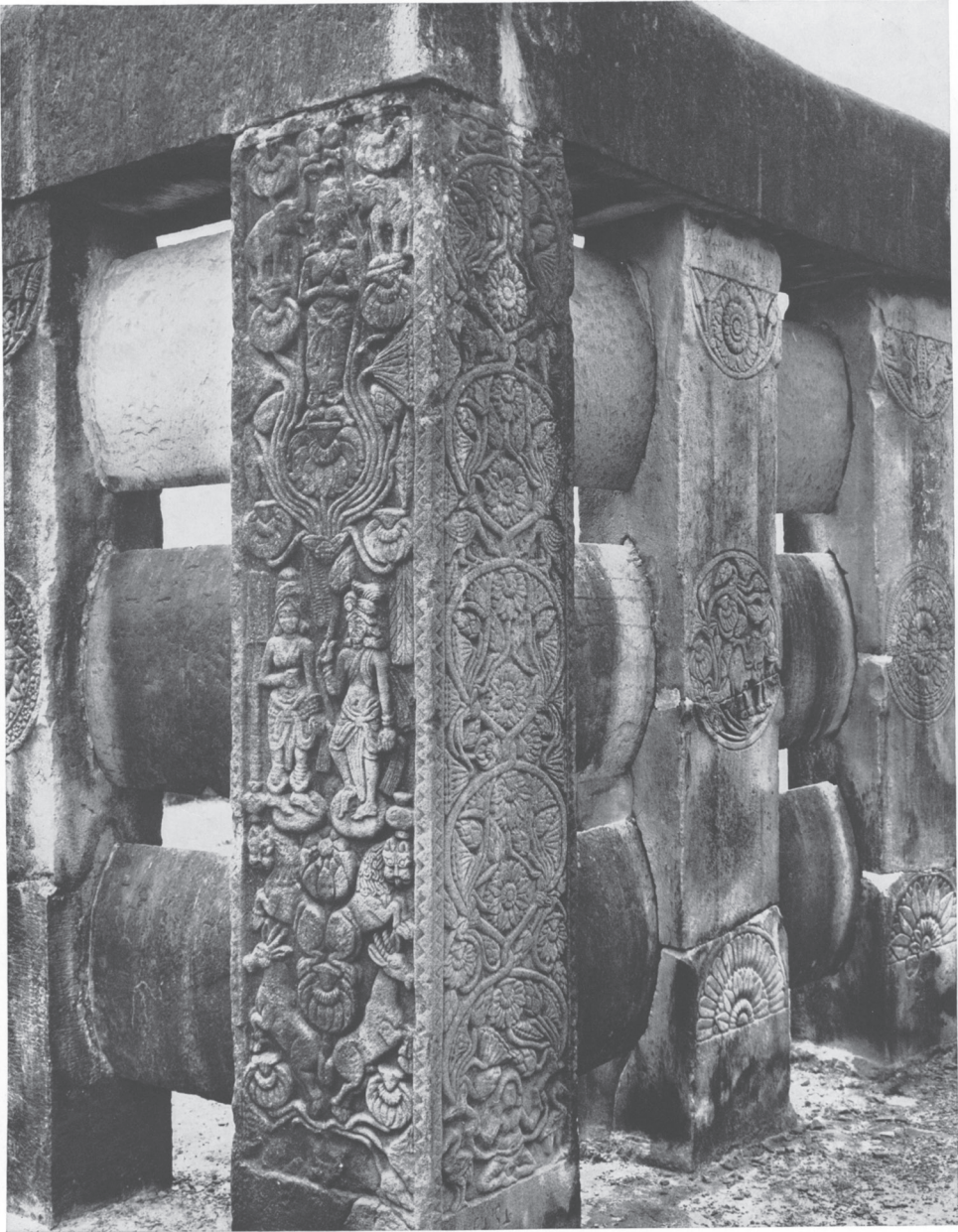
